Georgie Batten (MAINS PICTURE PERFECT)

Abby Douch (RAINWOOD PARK MELALEUCA)

We bought a 7yr old Mel in January 2017 - I was coming off a good 13.3hh showhunter/ allrounder pony who was always going to be hard to replace. We knew a little about Mel as Sarah Dreverman (my showjumping instructor) and her mum, Sue West, had bought Mel from Bruce Moxey as a youngster and started him in some local ASH classes and then Sarah campaigned him pretty successfully as a showjumper up to about 1.10m. Mel was much, much bigger than what we were looking for but it was plain to see that he was going to look after me if we took it slow and we've never looked back since.

I mainly do show hunter, working hunter, showjumping, interschools and ASH hack classes on Mel. In 2018 we ribboned at Canberra, Sydney and Melbourne Royal shows, Show Horse Council events, EA Show Horse and Showjumping events, State Interschools Championships and represented NSW at National Interschools where we were in the ribbons for Working Hunter and a part of the Pointscore State Show Horse team. We also competed successfully in some dressage and a couple of small One Day Events. Mel is also pretty handy on cattle but we just don't get time to go and do cattle events around our schedule of shows and competitions.

2019 I have had a slow start due to a full fracture of the coccyx in January but we have already had some great ribbons at our local ag shows, Canberra and Sydney Royals, Snowy Mountains Interschool Equestrian competition and very proud to again be representing NSW at National Interschools in September. My goal now with Mel is to consolidate at our next showjumping height and continue to focus on working hunter and ASH classes, keep improving his flatwork and my own riding.

I have to thank my brother Colby and Mum and Dad for all their help, they are both my main instructors. I also Thanks Bruce and Thea for breeding Mel and to Sue West for letting him go to us. But most of all thank you Mel.

Alena Duncan (HUNTS SURPRISE - HSH)

Alena is nine years old and has been riding her horse HUNTS SURPRISE - HSH for four years. Surprise is an 8yr old Bay mare, who was bred by family friend Lauren Sinderberry (we are quite fond of Lauren and Steve's Stock Horses as we have purchased a further three off her). Alena has been riding since before she could walk. She has competed at the Pony Club Association New South Wales State Championships in Sporting in 2016, 2017, 2018 and 2019 and the Queensland State Championships in 2017. In 2018 and 2019 she won Reserve State Age Champions, was named in the top four overall highest point scorers in the State of all ages and won numerous Championship titles and ribbons. In 2019 they also rode in the Pony Club Association New South Wales State Championships State Mounted Games and Team Sporting, where their team placed 4th in points overall for mounted games and 6th overall for team sporting. In 2017 Alena and Surprise won the Zone 14 champion show riding combination and overall high point champion. In 2018 they again won overall highest point champion, which has only been won two years running once before in the last 45 years.

Alena has had a beautiful bond with Surprise who has taken her to extraordinary heights at such a young age, but she is now taking a break in the paddock as she is due to have her first foal in October.



Zali Duncan (REMIX SPLASH)

For the last four years, Zali and Splash have won the Zone 14 Champion Sporting combination (which is achieved from fastest overall times of all ages) which is unprecedented in the awards 50-year history.

Splash has been the most exceptional horse for her to have as she has grown up. A very loyal mare, with a wonderful temperament and excellent ability, she is without a doubt Zali's best friend.

While university commitments reduced the opportunities to compete. Anastasia still managed to produce some outstanding results during 2018. Whilst she lent her "funny coloured horse" to her little brother to play polocrosse on and Campdraft, Anastasia still took her turn to win on him. At the Pony Club NSW State Sporting and Campdraft Championships in April, riding PALMERS COMEDY - HSH for the sporting they placed in all seven events, including winning the Flag Race in a cracking final and stealing the blue ribbon in the Diamond Flag from the Queenslanders. Anastasia was awarded Pointscore Champion for the 17-26 years age group, was a member of the Champion Zone team and the Champion State team (defeating Queensland for the title for the first time in seven years). The following day at the Campdrafting Championships Anastasia rode her home bred gelding THE ECHO POSTMAN, aka Decoy, to be Reserve Champion 17-26 years.

THE ECHO PHANTOM - HSH continued to develop and has become a great all-round horse, being pulled in out of the paddock and producing the goods whenever needed. Winning in all disciplines competed in during the year including hacking, sporting and campdrafting.





Nicole Martin — (MULWAREE CHARM)

MULWARREE CHARM continues to be Nicole's main mount for all events other than polocrosse (CHARM said "no" to polocrosse). Highlights for 2018 include; at the Pony Club NSW State Sporting and Campdrafting Championships in April Nicole finished top five both days, including winning the hotly contested three Mug final and, like her big sister, stealing the blue ribbon away from the Queenslanders in the Diamond Flag. At the Zone 7 Pony Club Jamboree Nicole was a member of the winning Team of four riders 13-25 years. This is the fourth year in a row that Nicole and MULWAREE CHARM have taken home this award (two years under 13yrs and now two years over 13yrs). They were also age champion, members of the winning Pointscore Team of four, and won 2nd of the six fastest sporting times of the day.

During 2018 Nicole commenced competing in the Tetrathalons $-\$ this relatively new discipline combines the four phases of running, swimming, shooting and showjumping. Nicole is currently long listed for the Pony Club National Championships for this event.

Clancy Martin (PALMERS COMEDY - HSH and **MULWARREE CHARM)**

2018 was a big polocrosse year for Clancy and PALMERS COMEDY - HSH. His first carnival of the season was the Australian Junior Polocrosse Classic at Albury where Clancy was selected to play in the first NSW Junior Mixed team. Playing against Queensland, Victoria, Western Australia, South Africa and the second NSW side, Clancy's team were undefeated at the carnival. Along with the Winners rug, Clancy was awarded Best Male No 3 and PALMERS COMEDY - HSH Best ASH played by a male. From there it was off to Warwick to play in the NSW Junior Boys team for the Interstate series against Queensland. The team claimed three wins from three games. The biggest achievement for the year came in July when Clancy was selected by the Polocrosse Association of Australia to play in the green and gold. A squad of eight girls and eight boys, from five different states, were selected to play a three game series against each other at a Polocrosse Association of Australia tournament. Clancy's team won this close fought series. Clancy finished off the season by being selected to play at the Australian Polocrosse National Championships in the NSW Junior Boys team. The championships were held in Perth Western Australia in October. Clancy made the long journey across the Nullabor with his family and horses and returned home with the winners prize – again his team were undefeated at the week long competition.

During the summer months Clancy also attended a few campdrafts, riding both PALMERS COMEDY - HSH and MULWARREE CHARM for some very impressive results. Clancy again qualified for the ABCRA National Finals Campdraft.
