#### RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

#### Rules

- The East Gippsland Branch of the Australian Stock Horse Society Show is conducted under the auspices of the Australian Stock Horse Society and shall be run in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Society.
- 2. All junior riders and horses are eligible to compete in open classes, as long as the horse is a registered Australian Stock Horse.
- 3. The Committee reserves the right to reject any entry.
- 4. The Committee reserves the right to cancel, combine, add or alter the sequence of classes or prizes as deemed necessary.
- 5. All entries are \$7 per class, unless otherwise stated. Junior events are \$2 per class, Junior challenges \$20.
- 6. All show entries close on the 6<sup>th</sup> of December 2024. Any late entries will be subject to double the entry fee.
- 7. No phone entries will be taken.
- 8. Neither the organising Committee nor the Australian Stock Horse Society Limited accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horse, riders, grounds, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.
- 9. All stallions and colts competing and staying overnight **MUST** be kept in the Campdraft Yards, unless competitors have their own portable yards. No other horses will be kept in Campdraft Yards overnight if stallions are there.

#### 10. **NEWCOMER RULES**

A horse that has not competed under saddle in any state / territory prior to a date determined by VMC. Date determined to be eligible as a Newcomer is from the day after the Victorian State Championships, until the day before the next Victorian State Championships.

All VMC Branch Shows are to run a Newcomer class.

Places 1st – 4th are eligible for the final to be held at the Victorian State Championships.

Once a horse has won a NC class at a Branch Show, it may not compete in another NC class until the Final at the Victorian State Championships.

Horse and rider must compete in the Final as the combination that qualified in the class.

Horses that are eligible for the Final will receive an invitation from VMC prior to the State Championships Final.

Date starts on the day after the 2024 Victorian State Championships and finishes the day before the 2025 Victorian State Championships.

- 11. All Juniors under 18 years must wear ASA approved helmets.
- 12. There will be no refund on scratching's after the closing date of entries unless accompanied by either a medical or veterinary certificate.

- High Point Awards: 1<sup>st</sup> = 4pts, 2<sup>nd</sup> = 3pts, 3<sup>rd</sup> = 2pts & 4<sup>th</sup> = 1pt
- High Point of the Show: 1<sup>st</sup> \$60, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$40, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$30 & 4<sup>th</sup> \$20
- SEAMC Junior Under 13 years events eligible for Hi Point; 36, 39, 42, 56
- SEAMC Juvenile 13 years and under 18 years events eligible for Hi Point; 37, 40, 43, 56
- SEAMC Associate 18 and under 21 years events eligible for Hi Point: 38, 41, 44, 56
- 14. All riders requiring a temporary day ASH Membership must pay this with their entries and sign all paperwork prior to riding. Youth \$20. Adults \$50. Must be paid with entries before close of entries.

- 15. All horses will be required to have & supply own breastplate numbers.
- 16. All horses are to be ridden in a snaffle bit.
- 17. Changes in Class Entries cannot be made with the Ring Steward unless the Show Secretary can confirm that an administration error occurred during processing.
- 18. All horses to be owned by a financial member of the Australian Stock Horse Society and handlers or riders must be a current member of the Society. All horses must appear as Competition Eligible on the ASHS website. It is your responsibility to ensure this is correct.
- 19. East Gippsland ASH Show and Challenge is to be run under the ASHS Drug Policy.
- 20. The Judge's decision will be final. Any protest must be lodged in writing to the Secretary within 30 minutes after the event and be accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 which is refundable if the protest is upheld.
- 21. High Point 3yr old of the show. Points to be collected from the following classes; Class 3, Class 8 & Class 34.
- 22. The Open Challenge will have a "cattle work" component. Riders entering this event please refer to the rules of this event.
- 23. It is a condition of entry that all competitors clean up all manure and hay from their parking site and yards. Please do not leave manure piled up beside yards, fill bags provided and leave at base of trees.
- 24. The presiding Judge and the President have the right to eliminate a competitor on unsafe cattle husbandry and the rider will be liable to pay cost of the animal if serious injury or death occurs.
- 25. Riders under 13 years **DO NOT** need to be on a registered ASH horse.
- 26. 13&under 21years **MUST** be on a registered ASH horse.
- 27. Juniors are not permitted to ride stallions or colts.




