CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- The Southern Highlands ASHS Branch Show is conducted in accordance with the current rules & regulations of the Australian Stock Horse Society Handbook for Committees, Judges, Competitors & Members
- Neither the Southern Highlands Branch ASHS nor the Australian Stock Horse Society will accept any liability for accident, damage, injury or illness to riders, handlers, horses, beasts, grounds, or any other person or property whatsoever
- The Committee reserves the right to alter the program at any time
- The Committee reserves the right to not accept entries
- All Entrants must be a financial member & all Exhibits must be registered with the Australian Stock Horse Society. No foal recorded horses will be accepted. Proof of registration & membership may be requested at any time
- Riders under the age of 13 years are permitted to compete on unregistered horses
- Day Membership will be available for NON ASHS members - payable with entries \$50.00 per adult / \$20.00 per child (under 18 years). Riders with day membership must be riding a registered ASH (riders under 13 excepted)
- The Judges' decision will be final. Any protest must be lodged within 30 minutes, in writing, along with a fee of \$50, refundable if protest is upheld
- Refunds requested after close of entries will be subject to administration fee. No refunds will be granted within 72 hours of event start without a valid Dr or Veterinary Certificate
- All Stallions or Colts must be double-tied or yarded when not competing. Whilst competing, ALL Stallions or Colts must be bitted at all times
- No Stallions or Colts will be permitted to be handled by riders under 18
- Stallions must be identified by green disc when competing – to be supplied by owner
- Any horse or person/s displaying unruly, dangerous or unsportsmanlike behaviour, this may include abuse, threatening of Judge, Officials or other Competitors, will be liable for disqualification & may be asked to leave the ring or venue
- All classes to be ridden in snaffle bit unless otherwise specified – no twisted bits, martingales, tie downs or hackamores allowed
- Helmets: Competitors under the age of 18 years MUST wear an approved ASA helmet when handling a horse within the perimeter of the grounds (on or off the horse AS PER ASHS rules & regulations with chin strap fastened at all times)
- Competitors whilst competing, do so at their own risk
- If competing more than one horse, please ensure you have enough handlers for each horse. To keep event program running smoothly & quickly we need your cooperation
- Horses must not be tied to trees
- Manure must be spread away on grassed areas away from trees
- No cash will be handled during this event. Please come prepared to pay electronically.

- **Stables and yards:** There are no stables on the ground, and limited uncovered yards available, first in best dressed. Electric fencing and portable yards are permitted. Please be mindful of fellow competitors when fencing off space.
- **Ground hire:** flat rate applies to all competitors, \$25 per vehicle to be paid with entries.
- **Camping:** there is very limited power available for camping, generators are recommended. Please be mindful of recreational campers sharing the Jugiong Rec Ground. Horses and competitors do have right of way over recreational campers, however please park in designated areas. Jugiong Rec Ground is maintained by volunteers, please leave the area neat and tidy

CLASS / EVENT DEFINITIONS

- **NOVICE:** A horse remains a Novice until it has won a relevant Novice or Open class at ANY show, open gymkhana or similar event, EXCEPT wins in age restricted, Youth and ASHLA classes. Any horse that wins an Open Championship, regardless of age, will no longer be a Novice.
- **SUPREME:** Any horse that wins a Supreme Ridden Class, regardless of age, will break its Novice status for BOTH Hack and Working, regardless of qualifying event.
- **PLEASURE:** No whips, spurs, crops, curb chains; simple snaffle bits only
- **ENCOURAGEMENT:** Rider 18 years & Over who have not won OVERALL in a Futurity, Maturity, Encouragement or Open challenge at any level. Encouragement riders may also enter in the Open and Hack Challenges. Horses 5 and over.
- **YOUTH CHALLENGE:** Riders must be under 18 years of age on the day. Youth Riders over 13 are eligible to compete in the Youth, Open and Hack Challenges
- **OPEN CHALLENGE:** Open to horses 5 years and over. Youth Riders over 13, and Encouragement riders are eligible to enter the Open Challenge

- **HACK CHALLENGE:** Riders any age, horses any age
- **ENTRIES:** Challenges, Futurities and Dressage **MUST** be pre-entered. Ring events on Saturday will be entry on the day, using **EFTPOS ONLY**. No cash will be kept on premises. All Ring classes \$5 per class unless otherwise stated.
- **PRIZE MONEY:** All challenge/futurity prize money will be paid via bank transfer. Bank account details must be provided with entries or prize money will be forfeited.
