Terms & Conditions

1. **AFFILIATION:** Events are Affiliated ACA and ASHS
2. All nominations include a \$15 stock levy
3. This program is dual affiliated with the ACA and ASHS. As such, participants must be either a member of ACA or of ASHS. ACA members will need to complete ASHS waivers. ASHS members will need to complete ACA waivers.
4. All ages are permitted to compete in open age drafts unless otherwise specified on the program.
5. **HELMETS:** Competitors under 18 years of age must wear an equestrian helmet approved by the current Australian Standards Association or International equivalent, which must be securely fastened under the chin, when mounted anywhere within the perimeter of the grounds, including all public areas, as well as in Led and Handler events.
6. **SCRATCHING:** A 100% refund of the nomination fee will be given if the competitor withdraws more than 168 hours (7 days) prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program. If a competitor withdraws less than 168 hours (7 days prior to 8:00am on the first morning of the program), then the entire nomination fee may be retained by the committee. If the committee deems that extenuating circumstances apply, then a refund may be granted. Each case will be at the discretion of the committee.
7. **HORSE'S STATUS:** The status of a horse winning a campdraft will be determined by the highest class of horse that competes with the exception of Juniors, Juveniles, Ladies, Mens, Old Buffers, Associates and Encouragement campdrafts. The winner attains the status of the highest class of horse participating (eg if one Open horse competes then it is classed as an Open draft).
8. **NOMINATION:** ASHS membership number must be provided otherwise your Stock horse and challenge nominations will not be processed. ACA requires all competitors to ensure details mirror that of their ACA member and horse profiles, across all non Campdraft One nominations platforms.
9. **JUVENILE/JUNIOR Campdraft:** Juvenile (13 years to under 17 years) and Juniors (8 years to under 13 years).
10. **COMPLAINTS:** "Any competitor who wishes to lodge a complaint at an affiliated campdraft must lodge the complaint in writing with the Secretary of the host committee within one (1) hour of the incident taking place. A fee of \$100 must be lodged with the complaint. If the complaint is dismissed by the Committee, the \$100 is forfeited".
11. **MEMBERSHIP:** All Competitors Must Be ASHS Members or Temporary Members to compete in stock horse classes and challenges.

12. STALLIONS: All Australian Stock Horse entires (2 years and over) must be doubled tied by a neck strap and halter on all showgrounds at all times when not in competition, exercised, led and ridden OR housed in suitable safe accommodation, such as securely fastened panels of a suitable height or appropriate stables. ACA: STALLIONS: All competitors that have stallions must abide by the rules and guidelines on page 18 of the rules and guidelines 11.11.
13. The committee has the right to alter to the program at their discretion.
