## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- ❖ Run under Australian Stock Horse Society Rules Handbook
- ❖ One horse/rider combination only is permitted per rider for all show classes, Handler, Hack, Rider, Working and Station Horse
- ❖ One rider per horse rule applies in each challenge group.
- ❖ Two horses are permitted per rider in challenge and sporting. The second horse cannot be entered in
  - ❖ another age groups or ridden by another rider.
- ❖ A horse cannot compete in different age groups –this applies to all events.
- ❖ You must compete on Saturday to be eligible to compete on Sunday, no exceptions
- ❖ Challenge Event consists of Hack, Working, Time Trail.
- ❖ Challenge – In event a of tie, countback will start with hack pattern, until resolved.
- ❖ ASHLA, junior judging, sporting and challenge entries are ineligible for High Point.
- ❖ All competitors must be a junior member or a junior participant member of ASHS
- ❖ Bits used must be within ASHS Rules and Regulations.
- ❖ Temporary memberships are not permitted.
- ❖ All horses must be competition eligible ASH Registered, including horses handled and ridden by competitors under 13 years of age.
- ❖ Under no circumstances, where an event is restricted to youth competitors (under 21 years of age), should any colts or stallions be permitted on the grounds at any youth ASHS event.
- ❖ Under no circumstances, are any persons (youth or adult) permitted to handle or ride stallions within the perimeter of the grounds at these events
- ❖ The committee has the right to alter or defer the programme or timing of events on the day, and classes may be moved into other rings at the discretion of the committee.
- ❖ No refunds will be given.
- ❖ ALL Competitors under 21 years of age must wear an Equestrian helmet - approved by the current Australian Standards Association or International equivalent, which must be securely fasten under the chin when mounted anywhere within the perimeter of the grounds, including all public areas, as well as in led and handler events.
- ❖ Dress Code - long sleeve shirt, tie, jodhpurs or stockman cut jeans with a coat or ASH jumper; exception of sporting events where polos and jodhpurs and jeans are allowed.
- ❖ All people entering the grounds, competitors and handlers, do so at their own risk. Neither the organising committee nor the ASHS Ltd accept any liability for any accidents, damage, injury or illness to horses, riders, spectators or any other person.
- ❖ Volunteers- all parents are required to volunteer.
- ❖ Under 8 competitors must ride unassisted.
- ❖ The judge's decision is final
- ❖ Protests must be lodged in writing no more than 30 minutes from the completion of the event.
- ❖ Protest must be lodged with a \$100 fee which will be refunded if protest is upheld.
- ❖ Nomination platform - Nominate (nominate surcharge apply)
- ❖ Age classes are determined by age of competitor on the first day of competition

The Northern Branch ASHS Committee would like to thank all our sponsors, they have been very generous, and we appreciate each and every one of you.

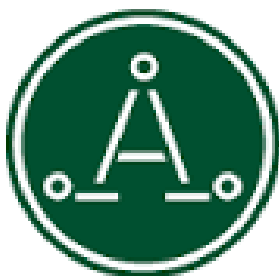

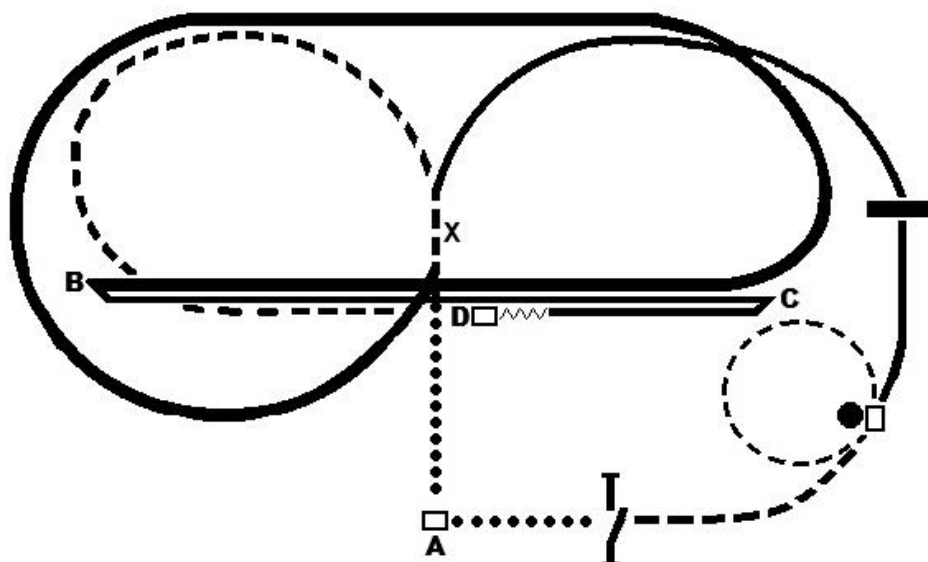

		Possible Points	Judge's Marks
1	Type, Presentation and Overall Impression	10	
2	Walk to gate. Open, pass through and close gate keeping hand on the gate at all times. (Under 13 do not need to close the gate)	10	
3	Trot to the drum. Stop and pick up the coat and trot a 10m circle to the left around the drum. Stop and replace the coat.	10	
4	Canter from the drum, over the obstacle and continue left to X. At X, simple change.	10	
5	Hand Gallop loop to the right and across to B.	10	
6	At B, rollback left.	10	
7	Canter to C, rollback right.	10	
8	Canter to D. Stop, settle, rein back 3 metres.	10	
9	Proceed on a large loop to the right at a trot to X.	10	
10	At X walk, proceed to judge at A cracking whip.	10
