HOW TO NOMINATE

National Show – 7th – 12th March 2026 AELEC, Tamworth, NSW

Entries Open: Monday 5th January 2026, 10:00 am (AEDST)

Nominations open to registered Australian Stock Horses owned by 2026 financial ASHS members as recorded in the Society Stud Book. All competitors, riders & handlers must be 2026 financial members to compete, NO TEMPORARY MEMBERSHIPS ARE AVAILABLE.

Entries Close: Friday 23rd January 2026, Midnight (AEDST)

You must have your ASHS Membership Number and Password to enter. We recommend that you have your list of horses, riders and the classes you want to enter to hand before you begin this process. We also recommend that only OWNERS of horses nominate them for the National Show. Horses registered to your Membership are the only ones that you can enter.

To enter a horse registered to somebody else please send the details of the horse (full registered name and registration number), the Owner's Membership Name & Number and your Membership details (Name and Membership number) to showsec@ashs.com.au, clearly marked "Urgent National Show Nomination". You must be a Full financial Member for this process to be completed.

To enter Click here: https://ashs.com.au/sportsevents/events/2026-ashs-national-show/. Then Click **ENTER HERE** on the right hand side of the screen.



Click on the Enter Here link (left of screen) for the **2026 National Show**. **PLEASE NOTE: THE LINK WILL NOT BE ACTIVE UNTIL NOMINATIONS ARE OPEN.** While nominations are open, the Enter button will be active.



Enter ASHS Membership Number

Enter ASHS Member Password

If you don't have your **ASHS Membership Password**, click "Forgot your password?" to reset and follow the prompts.

Click Submit







The following screen should come up. Here you begin your nominations and purchase of breastplates.

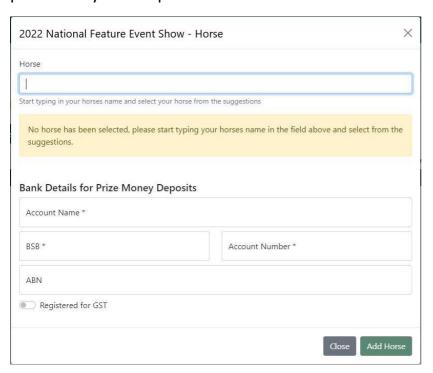


To purchase Breastplate numbers or any other Show specific items, click **Add Additional Items**.

Once you have completed and paid for your entries if you wish to scratch all your horses, *Click Cancel ALL Nominations*.

To add any entries you must begin with a horse. Click Add Horse.

When you click on *Add Horse* the following screen should appear. Here you enter the horse (by name) and then provide the bank details into which the prizemoney will be paid.



Start typing your horses name and select your horse from the suggestions.



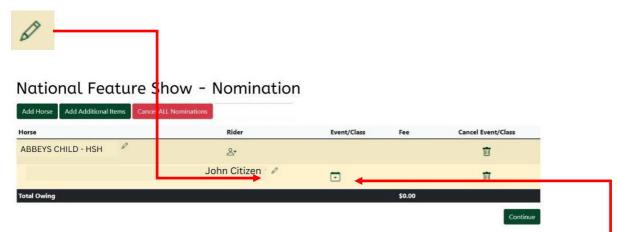




Type in your *Bank Details for Prize Money Deposits*, click the button beside *Registered for GST* if you are registered for GST, if not don't click. If registered for GST you will be prompted to enter your ABN. If you have entered this horse in the past these details will automatically be entered, check the details are still correct.

Once all this is complete, check it again, then click **Add Horse**.

The screen below should then come up with your horses' name.



Click the **Edit Rider** icon to change your rider, typing your riders' name and select your rider from the suggestions. If the rider is you then you do not need to change this, but you may need to add Emergency Contact, please check.

Once all this is complete, check it again, then click **Save Rider**.

Your riders' name should appear below the horse, as above.

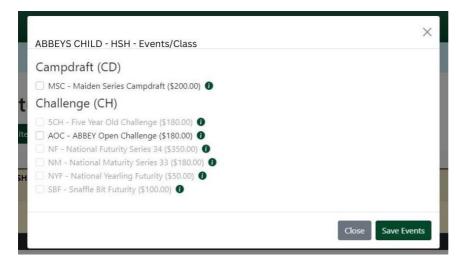
Now to enter your classes.... click the Add Class icon:







Select the events/classes you want to enter, all events/classes will be listed but only those the horse is eligible for can be selected. In example below as the mare is over 5 she can only enter Maiden Series Campdraft and ABBEY Open Challenge and 5 years and over classes.



Once all this is complete, check it again, then click **Save Events**.

Click Continue or

To add another horse, Click **Add Horse.** Repeat the above steps.

The next screen is the **Add Volunteer** screen.



Click the *Add Volunteer* icon to add your volunteer. The screen on the following page will come up.

Type in your volunteer name and their mobile number at show time. Select **Preferred Event** (which is the day of competition ie. Day 1 or Day 5) from the dropdown list, then Click the **Select Time Slot** button, this is for all day on the day selected, volunteers will be assigned to events/times closer to the Show. Click **Select Volunteer Position** button. Type in any special requirements (ie seated assignment required) in the **Any additional information**. Click on **Terms and Conditions** link and read, then click **Accept**.

Click Save Volunteer.

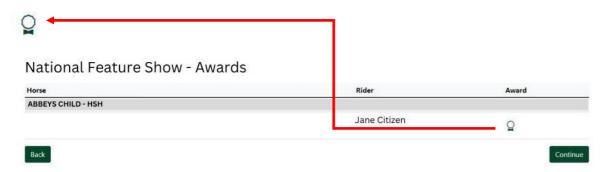
Click Continue.



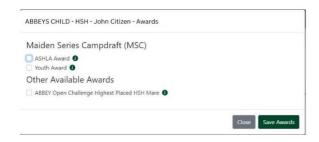




Click on the **Add Awards** icon



If there is an award in the events you have selected they will be listed on this screen and you will be able to select it. Select the correct awards. If there are no awards the pop-up will be blank. Click *Save Awards*. Do this for each horse you have entered. Then click *Continue*.



The next screen is the summary screen, it lists all the horses and events which you have entered along with the Volunteer details. Check that all the information on this screen is complete and correct.

- If not click the *Back* button to return to the appropriate screen and make any changes necessary. Click *Save* on any screen to which changes have been made, then click *Continue* to return to the Summary Screen.
- If all is correct then proceed below.

Finally, add or check the email address for the Tax Invoice.

Click *Accept Terms and Conditions* (click the link to review).

Scroll down the screen to the Payment details. Add your Credit Card details for payment then click the *Pay* button (bottom right of screen).

Your tax invoice will be displayed on the screen, check it. Then click *Logout* (top right of screen).







Your tax invoice will be emailed to the nominated email address, please check that all the horses have been entered in the correct classes.

It is the responsibility of the person entering the Show to check the events entered on your invoice within the nomination period (5th – 23rd January 2026). The Society takes no responsibility for errors in entries.





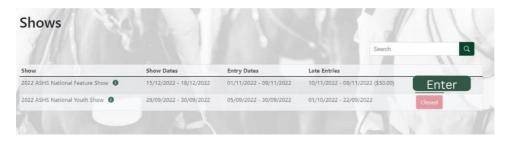


Reviewing or Changing your Nominations

To view / Edit a completed nomination during the Nomination period ($5^{th} - 23^{rd}$ January 2026).

Click here: http://ashsnoms.com.au/nomination/show/list. Then Click on **ENTER HERE** on the right hand side of the screen.

Click *Enter* to the right of the correct event.



Then click on **Nominations**.

Click the *view* icon to view Nominations, or click the *Edit* icon to edit the Nominations.

To **cancel a class / event,** click on the rubbish bin icon at the end of the line in which the class appears.

To **scratch** a horse, click on the same icon at the end of the line on which the horse name appears.

In both cases you will be asked to confirm your choice. Read the message and be sure that you are changing what you need to change.

Please check the National Show Entry Conditions for details regarding compulsory fees, changes to nominations (including riders or horses) or scratchings and applicable refunds (where eligible).

To scratch all your horses, Click Cancel ALL Nominations.
