Both pages must be printed or copied on A4 paper with a Good Quality PRINTER for Registration to be accepted. The Application for Registration needs to be submitted to the Society with payment of FEES and Proof of Breeding.

⇒ **NAME OF HORSE BEING REGISTERED** – 1st name preference

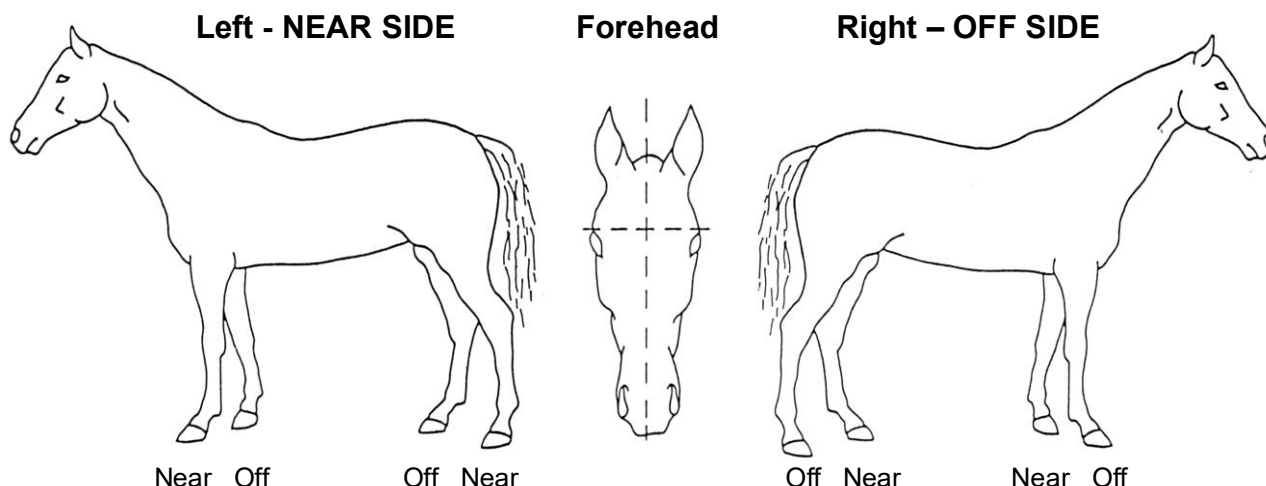
IDENTIFICATION OF HORSE

Branded with **CLEARLY VISIBLE BRANDS** - owner, identification and foaling season year brands), OR a **READABLE MICROCHIP**. If brands are not clearly visible, horse must be microchipped.

DIAGRAM OF HORSE - The microchip and/or brands and all markings must be accurately illustrated on the diagram of the horse. Any indentations, scars or hair whorls must be indicated and labelled accordingly.

⇒ **WHITE MARKINGS** – shaded in and accurately defining the shape of the marking on forehead, near and off views (**both sides**).

USE BLACK PEN ONLY – THE DIAGRAM AND THE CONTENTS OF THE BOX WILL BE SCANNED ONTO THE CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION.



If Microchipped, number:

White Marking – defining shape and SHADED IN Hair Whorl – o Scar – x Indentation – Δ

HORSE MUST BE BRANDED or MICROCHIPPED

LABEL OBSCURE OR UNUSUAL MARKINGS WHERE NECESSARY

INSPECTION – A Society Inspector appointed by the Board must inspect **First Cross** (mares and geldings), **Stud Book Thoroughbreds** (mares & stallions) and **Base Registry** (mares, geldings & stallions) after branding, or horse microchipped.

LOCAL AREA – Inspectors' list is on the Society's Website – Horses Page. Travel expenses are paid to Inspector. The horse must be inspected prior to lodging application, unless video footage for inspection is being submitted.

INSPECTION REPORT: Horse meets ASH standards, Colour, Markings and Brands are consistent with horse inspected.

An inspection pass does not constitute acceptance of any application, it will be considered in accordance with the Society Regulations. The Inspector must not have a pecuniary interest or conflict of interest with the owner or horse to be registered.

PHOTOGRAPHS – (Recommended, not compulsory) for ALL registration types. Photographs will become the property of The Australian Stock Horse Society Limited. They should include the front, near and off sides of the horse, showing as many visible markings as possible, including white markings, brands, scars, etc.

TRANSFER APPLICATION - horse being registered

NOT REQUIRED - if the progeny is being registered by the membership that owned or leased the dam at time of foaling.

NOT REQUIRED - if the Member registering the progeny, purchased the progeny as a foal at foot (under 365 days old), with the dam.

REQUIRED - If the member registering the progeny is different to the membership that owned or leased the dam at time of foaling and a transfer fee will apply.
